4. Business Arising from the Minutes

- RADF 2023 Community Grant Round: Four community grants were approved by Council \$10,117. Gulf Savannah NRM have since submitted revised project plan. Committee feedback on changes to event will be presented to Councillors in coming weeks.
- RADF 2023 Council led initiatives: 1. Mareeba Skate Bowl contract has been awarded to Daniel Wallwork; 2. Kuranda Visitor Information Centre proposals currently being considered; 3. Mt Molloy Remembrance Mural has been completed.

5. General Business

- Arts Queensland will move to three-year RADF funding agreements to allow long term strategic initiatives and reduced administration. RADF funding round will open soon.
- Proposed three-year RADF Program was presented, including Public Mural Action Plan implementation (Y1 and Y2), arts / culture community consultation (Y3) and annual grant round and annual increase in Program budget.
- Motion: That the RADF Advisory Committee recommends to Council the proposed 3 year RADF Program including a request for Arts Queensland grant funding totalling \$100,500, and a Council contribution of \$45,000 to implement Council led activities and annual community grant round to achieve outcomes for youth arts engagement, cultural tourism and public mural partnerships.
