7. General Business

- Arara Street Kuranda community issue / development proposal request of supporting letter for Skyrail: Kevin Parise explained Skyrail's concerns regarding the proposed Arara St location including its proximity next to two of Kuranda's major attractions, Skyrail and Kuranda Scenic Rail Following discussion it was agreed that Tourism Kuranda will provide a letter to Craig Crawford supporting Skyrail's objection to the proposed location.
- Process for renewal of TK committee: Lisa Macalister outlined the requirement for Council to appoint the Tourism Kuranda Committee for a new three year term. The current Terms of Reference advise:

7. Committee Term

- 1.1. The committee is appointed for the term of 3 years and may be renewed with the same membership at this point or expressions of interest called for positions.
- 1.2. Expressions of interest will be called no later than 30 August of the year the previous term ceases and new appointments shall commence from no later than the September of that year.

Agreement that: Advertisement to be placed in August Kuranda Paper and Council's website calling for expressions of interest. TK will use network to promote membership.

Rob Matthews has advised he will not renew and therefore a new Accommodation Representative would be needed. Mel Wicks has also advised that she will be resigning from the committee from the end of August, but is willing to remain as acting Chairperson until December 2015, if necessary. TK members intending to renew: Cathy Flambo, Terry Pates, Karen Ewin, Kevin Parise or Skyrail rep, Chris Gratham and Adrian Pancirov. Mel Wicks acknowledged the willingness of the current TK members to volunteer their services for another three year term.

Applications to close Friday 14 August. A Council report to go Council on 19 August will make membership recommendations and approve new TK Advisory Committee Terms of Reference, table the new TK Strategic Plan, and gain Council confirmation regarding TK's accommodation.

- Draft Kuranda VIC business plan: Catherine Harvey distributed copies of the plan to Kevin Parise
 and Mel Wicks. Kevin and Mel. Rest of committee also to receive copies except for Cathy Flambo as
 there was a conflict of interest. Agreement for feedback by 1st August.
- **City Slider**: New date set for 26 September. They are giving refunds. No new application has been submitted yet to Council.
- **Accommodation Group**:. Sub-committee is part of revised strategic plan. Marc Sleeman suggested Peter Danford from Cedar Park Resort might be interested in chairing group.
- Grants: TEQ's Queensland Destination Events Program (QDEP) Round 2 funding applications are
 now open for <u>Destination Event funding</u> and <u>Significant Event funding</u>. Applications close 30 October
 2015. Community Gambling Development fund closes 31st August. Priorities are for facility upgrades
 or equipment needs. TK would need to be auspiced by an incorporated community group to be
 eligible.
- Business name up for renewal: Agreed to renew with same name Tourism Kuranda.
- The TK Executive Officer, Marc Sleeman is on standby from 17 August as Juror for 2 weeks.
- Lisa Macalister advised the Committee she will be leaving Council with last day on 28 August. The Senior Engagement Officer position is advertised. <u>See msc.qld.gov.au/senior-engagement-officer/</u>

While the day sessions were popular, not so many people were willing to brave the cooler evening in Kuranda. The event organizers have taken the advice from locals and moved it to the following school holidays.

LOCAL SALES CALLS – I spent 4 days during the month completing local sales calls and delivering brochures to our main booking outlets. Prior to ATE I ensured brochures were distributed across our major distribution points like Freshwater Station & KSR Cairns Central, Kuranda Station, Skyrail terminals and the main outlets in Cairns CBD. I also did a brochure run across the Atherton Tablelands and visited all the VIC to Mission Beach & Tully who all report an increase in visitor numbers.

ATEC COMMITTEE— During the month I attended an ATEC committee meeting to discuss the upcoming IUN event in October.

UKULELE BBQ KURANDA – The ukulele BBQ was held in Kuranda on the 4th & 5th July 2015. Now in its fifth year, this annual community music event is hosted by pioneering Kuranda ukulele performers, Bosko & Honey, and was a special event this year. We provided the event with social media exposure and forwarded event press release to all of our media contacts and included a story in our monthly e-newsletter which resulted in securing the front page of the Kuranda Paper.
