My company "Rotocult Pty Ltd" owns Lot 24 on SP 193149 at 41 Coolamon Close, Mareeba, with an area of 27.25ha. The current improvements include two large shed and there is an eighty mega litre water allocation.

My neighbour Ross Reid (R & T Reid Holdings Pty Ltd CAN 15174524 Trustee under instrument 719000155) owns property being **Lot 138 SP179170**, wants to purchase part of my farm (60 acres/ 24.281ha) and 70 megs of water. Mr Reid's farm is now fully planted with bananas and he wishes to make his farm more viable by increasing his area.

My surveyor Roger Twine has indicated that as his property adjoins mine, this would be possible by an alteration of boundary and amalgamate the 24.281ha to his land.

I would be left with 2.97ha with the two sheds and 10 megs of water. The adjoining lands are all 2ha parcels of land and have small orchards on them.

I ask that the council approve this alteration to the boundary to allow Mr Reid to purchase my land. Attached is a proposed plan together with easements to facilitate road access and water access. The easements are necessary as there is a drainage area between the two parcels of land.
