A further Information Request is made by the assessment manager, as detailed below:

1. Road A

- (i) Confirm the proposed width of Road A as 7.5m.
- (ii) Provide further details about how stormwater will be managed at the temporary turnaround areas at the end of Country Road and Road A.

2. Intersection

Provide swept paths showing design vehicle (school bus 12.5 or 14m) for Country Road and Road A.

3. Proposed drainage easement within Lot 57

Council requires further treatment from the pipe outlet to creek/gully. This could possibly be in the form of a concrete invert to the gully with protection.

4. Emerald End Road Widening

(i) Drawing CRE17-018-C66 shows the Typical Cross Sections for the widening on Emerald End Road. Add a dimension on the sections that show the width between


the existing centreline on Emerald End Road and the Layback Kerb and Channel Invert/Edge of Bitumen Seal.

Emerald End Road is classed as a Rural Road Collector Major and therefore requires a 10m formation, so from the existing centreline to the Layback Kerb and Channel Invert/Edge of Bitumen Seal, should be 5.0m

(ii) Detail how temporary arrangements will prevent drainage issues in this area with the table drain being lower than the new Kerb and Channel and therefore not being able to drain.

5. Water

To ensure that the 63mm return line can be isolated at the areas indicated below in orange, Council requires an addition sluice valve to be placed at both locations:
