#### PART 5 - SCOPE

#### **Design Brief**

The artwork should reflect *Kuranda's unique natural environment* to create a distinctive sense of place for visitors and residents. The artwork should respond to the location and pedestrian viewing points. The purpose of the mural is to enhance the visual appeal of public spaces to improve liveability and amenity of the Shire.

#### Site

The Kuranda Visitor Information Centre is located in Centenary Park, corner Coondoo and Therwine Streets Kuranda. The facility is owned and operated by Mareeba Shire Council for tourism purposes. The mural will be located along the two back walls of the Centre.

The artwork must be completed off site and painted onto pre-cut and undercoated, 4mm aluminium cladding that will be supplied by Council. There are 19 individual panels ( $6 \times 515$ mm  $\times 1615$ mm;  $9 \times 514$ mm  $\times 1800$ mm;  $4 \times 515$ mm  $\times 410$ mm) with a total area of approximately 14.2m $^2$ . Council will arrange clear coat and installation.

#### PART 6 - Proposal Requirements

- Artists should submit a written proposal that addresses the following specific items:
  - Short written design statement and optional visual sketch designs.
  - Demonstrated ability and experience creating original, quality artworks.
  - Availability to complete the artwork within the specified timeframes.
  - Itemised schedule of fees, that may include:
    - o Design fees (including one scaled, sketch design and one revision)
    - o Artist fees / labour (including expected time required to paint mural)
    - o Materials and equipment (not including panels, undercoat, clear coat, installation)
    - Travel and accommodation expenses (if required, including pick up / delivery of panels from Mareeba)
