Supplementary Rate Notice FACT SHEET





Supplementary rate notices are issued by Council when there has been a change to the rating records since the last half-yearly rate notice. Common adjustments are made to general rates and utility charges.

The changes are usually calculated on a pro-rata basis from the date the changes take effect.

Examples of general rates adjustments are:

- Change in the rateable valuation on of the property as issued by the Department of Resources, such as new valuations, cancelled valuations and increases or decreases.
- Change of land use.
- Reconfiguration of a lot including subdivisions.

Examples if utility / service adjustments are:

- Commencement of a mobile bin service.
- A variation in the number of mobile bins.
- Adjustment of water and/or sewerage charges due to the completion of building or structures.

If adjustments to the rates and charges are required because they're incorrect, Council will issue a supplementary notice.

All adjustments processed are in accordance with section 109 to 115 of the *Local Government Regulation 2012*.
