All dogs that are kept at the property address must be registered at the time of application. The *Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008* requires all dogs over the age of 3 months to be registered within the relevant local government area.

Applications will not be considered until all animals (where applicable) that currently reside at the property are registered. Approval from the property owner (including QLD Housing Commission) must be granted prior to submitting this application.

All applicants must comply with the minimum standards for the keeping of the animal/s, including any conditions that may be applied to an approved application. An onsite inspection by an authorised council officer is required prior to the granting of this application. Applications are not transferrable between properties or owners, or refundable. Animal species that are prohibited on the property will not be approved.

Animal identification

- Dogs must wear the registration tag supplied by the local government.
- Stock must have a distinguishing brand, bolus, ear tag and or be micro chipped. The owner of one or more head of stock or 100 or more poultry including caged birds must be registered with Biosecurity Queensland.
- Birds excluding poultry must have an identifying leg band or be micro-chipped.
