LODGEMENT INFORMATION

By virtue of Section 90 of the *Local Government Regulation 2012*, the lodgement of an objection or the commencement of an appeal does not stop the Mareeba Shire Council levying and recovering Rates on the specified land.

To prevent any outstanding debt from being deferred to a debt collection agency, it is suggested that all outstanding amounts are paid in full ***prior to lodging an objection***. Any adjustments that are applicable will be processed after the objection has been investigated by Council.
