# Marketing Kuranda - Village in the Rainforest -

#### Kuranda means tourism

As one of the most visited destinations in wider Tropical North Queensland, tourism is the most significant economic driver for the Kuranda area. The Kuranda business community and Mareeba Shire Council recognise the collaborative promotion of Kuranda and development of positive visitor experiences are economic imperatives.

Tourism Kuranda (TK) is a dedicated destination marketing and development programme to grow, capitalise on and protect the Kuranda brand, to realise the region's potential as a "must do" tourism destination and support industry efforts to ensure every visitor experience is a positive one.

## Solid foundations

Tourism Kuranda is an initiative of the Mareeba Shire Council with destination marketing and development funded by a special charge levied on commercial rate payers, tourism and accommodation services in the Kuranda district. Post arrival visitor services to enhance the visitor experience and encourage longer stays are funded by general rates paid by shire ratepayers.

### **Tourism Kuranda Advisory Committee**

A Tourism Kuranda Advisory Committee, established by Council under the *Local Government Regulation 2012*, provides expert information, advice and recommendations to Council regarding the strategic tourism promotion and development of Kuranda. Volunteer members with tourism, business and marketing industry expertise are appointed for three year terms. The Committee meets monthly on the fourth Tuesday.

### **Calling for committee nominations**

The Tourism Kuranda Advisory Committee is due for renewal and nominations are invited from suitably experienced and committed persons with tourism, business and marketing industry expertise by **31 Jan 2019**.
