The Lasting Legacies grant is available for projects that acknowledge the First World War or significant Queensland military milestones in the past 100 years.

<b>Grant provider</b>	Anzac Centenary Coordination Unit, Department of Premier and Cabinet
<b>Funding program</b>	<b>Lasting Legacies - Queensland Anzac Centenary Large Grants Program</b>
<b>Availability of grant</b>	Funding Round 6 opens 21 August 2017 and closes 28 January 2018.
<b>Availability of funding</b>	Funding of between \$20,001 and \$80,000 for projects and activities that are significant from a state perspective and will be delivered within 12 months (by 31 December 2018.)
<b>Co-contribution</b>	Applicants must contribute at least 25% of the total project costs (excluding in-kind support, private sponsorship and funding from other programs.)
<b>Eligibility</b>	Applicant organisations must be operating on a not-for-profit basis with a valid ABN and include local councils, universities, parents and citizens associations, incorporated associations and not for profit corporations.
<b>Objectives of program</b>	The objectives of the program are to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• raise community awareness of the centenary of the First World War</li><li>• contribute to a statewide program</li><li>• promote the Anzac values of courage, integrity, resilience, mateship, teamwork, duty and sacrifice, demonstrated by Queenslanders both at the front and at home in Australia</li><li>• encourage community participation and engagement of diverse, inclusive and educational Anzac Centenary projects and activities</li><li>• promote social, cultural or economic benefit to the community</li><li>• leave a legacy for future generations.</li></ul>
<b>Eligible Projects</b>	Grants are available for projects that acknowledge the First World War or significant Queensland military milestones in the past 100 years, for example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• historical research and education - digital innovation</li><li>• the acquisition and preservation of war memorabilia</li><li>• the restoration or enhancement of existing memorials and honour boards</li><li>• public commemorative events, arts and culture.</li></ul> Eligible and ineligible costs are listed in the application guidelines.
