HOW TO

BORROW

Magazines and very popular fiction have a loan period of 2 weeks, other items can be borrowed for 4 weeks. Items can be renewed twice unless they have been reserved by another customer. It is easy to renew your items online using the library catalogue or they can be renewed in person or by phone.

You will need to have your library card with you to borrow.

RETURN

Items can be returned to any of our 4 libraries 24/7 through the after-hours chute. Items returned 21 days or more past the due date will attract a charge.
